

Damage Assessment Report: Khorasan Razavi Province

Introduction

Following the outbreak of recent riots and street disturbances, there has been a widespread and unprecedented surge in terrorist acts and sabotage. Given the necessity of clarifying these terroristic and destructive measures and preventing the formulation of unfounded human rights allegations, providing an accurate narrative to inform the international community is essential. To this end, a series of documented reports will be prepared and dispatched. Accordingly, the following report details a portion of the damages inflicted upon state, public, and private property across Khorasan Razavi Province on January 8th and 9th, 2026 (18-19/10/1404). This series will be subsequently completed with further reports regarding attacks on religious centers (such as mosques), private vehicles, residential homes, and commercial shops.

Damages to Public and Private Banks

1. Total Destruction: 27 bank branches were completely destroyed, including 24 branches in Mashhad and 3 branches in other counties across the province.
2. Structural Damage: 45 branches sustained damage (including broken windows, doors, and destruction of ATMs and CCTV cameras). Additionally, one "Shahr-Net" (automated digital booth) and one Shahr Bank kiosk were damaged.

Damage and Sabotage to Water, Electricity, and Telecommunications Infrastructure

- * Water and Wastewater (ABFA): Forced entry, looting of assets, and destruction of the Mashhad Water and Wastewater Administration building.
- * Arson: Use of Molotov cocktails in administrative buildings and destruction of office equipment at the Water Supply Building.
- * Pumping Stations: Damage inflicted upon water pumping stations.
- * Electricity Department Facilities: Total destruction of suites and the prayer hall (Namaz-Khaneh) at the Electricity Club.
- * Direct Attacks: Attack and destruction of the District 7 Electricity Distribution Office (Madar Square, Mashhad) and the arson of two service vehicles.
- * Infrastructure Sabotage: Arson of an aerial electricity transformer in Torbat-e Heydarieh.
- * Nishapur District: Attack and destruction of the Nishapur Electricity Management building.
- * Telecommunications: Destruction of 9 major Irancell sites in the province, including 3 sites within the city of Mashhad.

* Infrastructure Arson: Burning of 9 telecommunication cross-connect cabinets (KV) across the province.

Trade Guilds and Unions

* Looting: Raiding and looting of 55 branches of "Ofiq Kourosh" retail stores across Khorasan Razavi Province.

Mashhad Municipality

* Public Transport: Arson of 6 public transport buses.
